

## **Pillow wrap**

## General instructions-

Measure your pillow and add about 4" to the diameter measurement for a closure. I will use Velcro, buttons and buttonholes or snaps. In this example I will use a 16" pillow. Our finished wrap measures 34 ½" X 11 ½". The size was determined by the patchwork created. You can make your wrap wider or more narrow as needed.

## ZIG- ZAG pillow wrap

I used 2 fat quarters or you need to purchase a  $\frac{1}{2}$  yard of 2 contrasting fabrics. Cut 2 – 45" X 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips of each color or 4 – 22" X 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips from fat quarter for the 2 colors.

Serge or piece the 2 contrasting strips together and press the seam to one side. Cut the strips into 2 ½" strips.

Layout your zig zag rows for a pleasing affect and piece together in rows and then piece in rows to create the finished block for the finished length of the wrap.



I used a rick rack trim on the edge and backed the wrap with a pre quilted fabric. Sew together like a pillow leaving enough room to turn the wrap. You can top stitch to hold the edges in place. Add Velcro to finish the wrap. Now you can remove and add different wraps to change the pillow theme.
