



Strip pieced placemat with applique – 4 mats

You will need

Rotary cutter and ruler, scissors, and a fabric marker

¼ yd of each - At least 6 different prints that coordinate cut 2” wide

½ yd of a solid fabric for cross

¼ yd for flower applique and ¼ yd for flower center (can be used in strip piecing)

1 yd of Wonder under fusible webbing

1 yard for binding (can be the same as flower)

1 yard of double faced pre quilted fabric for batting and backing

1 spool thread to match quilted fabric



Cut your placemats from the pre quilted fabric. From 1 yard you can cut 3 placemats across the 45” length approximately 14” and width 18”

Draw your cross placement on the placemat. Make sure each mat matches the cross placement.

Starting from the cross line, piece the strips as shown in the picture. Our strips are cut wider than the example shown. Strip piece to complete each direction.

To cover the joint where the cross was drawn, take the cross fabric and press under ¼” on each side. Pin the cross fabric over the joint and top stitch the cross strip in position, covering the joint in each direction.

Applique the flower at the center of the cross.

Bind the placemat to finish

Picture is a reference. Our placemat used less colors to strip piece.
